# 2025 Schull Annual Conference In Mishima, Japan

### 1) Hotel information for Mishima City, Japan

\*You could also find hotels near main Shinkansen (bullet train) stops -Tokyo Station, Shinagawa station) and commute from Tokyo bullet train to Mishima easily.

Mishima is a small town, so you could walk around the downtown between hotel and the conference site easily. But near the station might be most convenient if you stay near the station. Food is good in Mishima and much cheaper than Tokyo, so economical to stay in Mishima.

**2) Conference venue** - name and street address - Yuyu Hall, Shizuoka Prefecture Mishima City Ichiban-cho 20-5 <a href="https://mishima-youyouhall.com/">https://mishima-youyouhall.com/</a>, The venue is close to Mishima Station.

## 3) Airport to fly into Tokyo - Narita/Tokyo airport or Haneda/Tokyo airport.

Haneda is closer to the central Tokyo, so recommend you fly into Haneda.

Haneda to Tokyo Station (<a href="https://www.rome2rio.com/map/Tokyo-Haneda-Airport-HND/T%C5%8Dky%C5%8D-Station#trips">https://www.rome2rio.com/map/Tokyo-Haneda-Airport-HND/T%C5%8Dky%C5%8D-Station#trips</a>) 15 min taxi ride might be simplest. Uber is also possible in Tokyo.

## 4) Conference Schedule

Best dates to block out for arrival and departure

Arrive at Tokyo on Thursday 13 March or Friday 14 March 2025

\*Japan is 13/14 hours ahead of the US, so you need to leave US a day before the date you want to arrive. Direct flight is 14 hours average. If you leave late morning in the US, the flights arrive around mid-afternoon and custom takes a long time, so you will need enough time to get to Mishima.

After arriving at Tokyo, you can just stay in Tokyo and go to the meeting next morning, or travel to Mishima, Shizuoka Prefecture on the same day via (bullet train) and stay near the meeting place in Mishima.

Saturday and Sunday 15 and 16 March 2025 – Conference days

Monday and Tuesday 17 and 18 March 2025 – Return days or travel to other parts of Japan

## 5) Additional side trips

We might be able to organize a trip to RERF in Hiroshima.

You can easily travel to Kyoto or elsewhere if you have time. If you plan to go elsewhere, obtain Japan rail pass before you leave the US. With the rail pass, you can get almost any train with a reserved seat, except for the firstest bullet train and subway. Considering the one way ticket to Mishima is \$46/47, it is cheaper to get one week Japan Rail Pass if you plan to travel elsewhere.
